2006 FALL EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING
AUGUST 31, 2006
ST. CHARLES, MISSOURI

The meeting was called to order by President Ron Boese at 1:10 P. M..

The invocation was given by First Vice President Gene Doser.

President called for a roll call of Officers. All Officers were present except Organizer Ron Harvey.

President Boese explained that the minutes of the previous Mid-Winter Meetings were in the packet for everyone to review.

President Boese explained all aspects of Competition, along with all committee assignments.

President Boese explained that he received a request from the El Zagal Motor Patrol in Fargo, North Dakota to participate with us in Competition. President Boese explained that we will have a different type of award different from the usual trophy. All awards will be a clear acrylic with the Motor Corp wings and lettering engraved on them. He felt it was time that we look at other types of awards other than the same old trophy that everyone already has.

First Vice President Jim Tracy explained that Lee Widman of Moolah Yomo was tragically killed in a auto accident while he stopped to help another motorist. Lee was a person that always put the welfare of others before himself. Jim asked that the Motor Corp consider awarding a traveling award in his memory.

President Boese suggested that this years hospital donation be made in the memory of Past President Dean Marsh.

President Boese explained that the Imperial Sir Nicholas Thomas will be at our Fall Meeting and asked that the Executive Board make him an Honorary Member of CSASMC. After a unanimous vote, President Boese explained that he will present Imperial Sir Thomas with a set of CSASMC wings and a Motor Corp shirt with the Honorary Membership designation.

President Boese announced that the 2007 Mid-Winter Meeting will be April 12-14 in Hutchinson, Kansas.

The Meeting was adjourned at 2:30 P.M..
