

Second Vice-President Bob Sides explained that CSSA 2005 will be in Overland Park. We will not know until September whether we will be able to use a field at the local high school for Competition. He explained that this is the #1 pick of several sites that he has looked at. If for any reason that we will not get this site, the other choices will still be fine. The Awards Banquet will be at Overland Park Convention Center that will seat up to 1500 people and will be less than \$30.00. He has contacted the Blue Knights for judges. The 2006 Mid-Winter Meeting will be in Lincoln, NE.

Third Vice-President Ron Boese explained that CSSA 2006 will be in St. Charles, Missouri. Our Competition and Awards Banquet will be at the Family Arena.

Fourth Vice-President Gene Doser explained that CSSA 2007 will be in Kansas City, Missouri. The Motor Corp Competition will be at Arrowhead Stadium as in the past, and that the Awards banquet will be at the Marriott Hotel.

Sgt-at Arms Jim Tracy explained that the web site name for the Motor Corp comes up for renewal this year and that we should consider the fee of approx. \$120.00 to lock our name in for 10 years along with the fee to host the web site. It was decided to discuss this on the floor to be sure that there is adequate use of the web site to justify the expense.

Past President Bob Ware showed everyone a small cone to consider for purchase to replace some of the aging and sorry looking cones we now use. It was decided that after the purchase and set up of the new trailer that we should look into replacement of some of the equipment if we have the necessary funding.

Past President Bob Giesen suggested that the Secretary make up a list of Policy and Guideline that we should have printed for the use of the Officers as the progress up the line to the hot seat.

Past President Jack Neff explained that he would like to see us go back to inspecting all vehicles and personnel on the inspection lone. He felt that it was unfair to the larger Units that prepare all their equipment only to have 4 looked at, or we should consider going to the bonus point system as used by the Show Cars.

President Petersen open the floor for discussion on the bids that were proposed for a new trailer.

Darrell David presented at bid from a dealer in Oklahoma City for \$3400.00


Ron Boese presented a bid from a dealer for \$3700.00
