MID-WINTER EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING

The meeting was called to order by President Darrell David at 2:05 P.M.

First Vice-President Bob Sides- Competition in Overland Park will be at the Johnson County School District in Olathe. The field site has no obstructions so a full size drill field can be used. The Blue Knights will be doing the judging. The Awards Banquet will be at the Overland Park Convention Center and will seat up to 1500 people. No location for the Thursday meeting has been set. The 2006 Mid-Winter Meeting will be April 22 in Lincoln Nebraska.

President Darrell David reported that everything went very well in Des Moines and thanked everyone for their help. He commented that CSSA 2008 in Oklahoma City will be at the fairgrounds and Gene McKelvey will be the Director General. All the Texas Temples will be invited to attend and there is a possibility that they may join us in Competition. President David mention that Past President Jerry Ritchey will store the metal stanchions that were replaced with the new plastic ones.
